Appendix 1. Preparation for opening church for private prayer

Zoom meeting held on 17th June 2020

Present. Fr Gregory, Gary Clothier, Anne Mullis, Katherine Harrison, Ann Isbell, Gill Cox, Robert Pask.

In attendance Sharon Waight (adult safeguarding).

After much discussion, it was decided that:

- Church would be open three times a week. Mondays, Thursday and Saturday for two hours at a time.
- We must be as open and welcoming as possible.
- Two volunteers should be on hand to steward and clean each chair after use. Anne Mullis to arrange a rota.
- Front door would be the entrance and exit and the hall door would be for wheelchairs only.
- The parish centre including toilets would be (out of bounds)
- An altar would be set up on the dais and the Blessed Sacrament exposed.
- Father Gregory would be there at the beginning and end of each session.
- A deep clean would take place on Friday 19th and chairs arranged two metres apart in the nave.
- Posters would be put up as well as various Covid warning posters.
- Worshippers would be asked to use hand gel on entering church. Face masks would also be available for those who want them.
- Candles would be laid out on a table to avoid cross contamination, and a donation box would be placed on a table on the way out.
